Each heading is a well written topic sentence that references one of the thesis statement’s supporting points Every sentence in the “paragraph” supports the topic sentence	8		
Outline extended to <b>THREE LEVELS</b> consistently	20		
Parenthetical citations used throughout outline – use appropriate format. An outline without appropriate parenthetical references cannot earn higher than a “C” or average grade. All sources identified with page numbers (including <i>Internet</i> sources)	8		
Correct grammar and spelling Correct outline format (no “1” without a “2”..., indentations... see model in writing packet) Use transitions throughout to create a “flow” between ideas and paragraphs – use “Transition” sheet to assist you in the writing process Five sections (introduction, 3 supporting paragraphs, and conclusion). Each supporting paragraph is a reflection of one of the supporting points of the thesis statement Outline is 300 to 600 words	10		
Complete Works Cited page AND Works Consulted page(acceptable references) – MLA format	10		
Followed typing guidelines, this page filled out prior to entering class on the due date	10
